Changing the Date of the Presidential Primary

For any year where a primary for the President of the United States takes place, the primary will occur on the third Tuesday of March instead of the third Tuesday of May. Currently, Pennsylvania's presidential primary occurs on the fourth Tuesday of April. This bill will move Pennsylvania's presidential primary up by more than a month.

This act shall take effect in 60 days.
